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## **GCAAR** housing stats | November '21

Median sold price in region was \$580,000, an increase of 3.9% from November 2020; average days on market in November: 24 days

ROCKVILLE, Md. – The median sold price for residential properties in the region for November was \$580,000, representing a decrease of 2.4% compared to last month and an increase of 3.9% from November 2020. The average days on market for units sold in November was 24 days, 17% below the 5-year November average of 29 days.

The November information is the latest from the Greater Capital Area Association of REALTORS® (GCAAR), representing sales data for the <u>Washington</u>, <u>D.C.</u> and <u>Montgomery County</u> markets. Closed sales for the region totaled 2,089, representing a 0.1% increase in closed sales when compared to the previous month and up 2.3% compared to November 2020.

In the District, there were 854 closed sales in November (a 6.2% increase from the previous month), while the median sold price was \$725,000, a 2.8% increase from the previous month and a 6.6% increase from November 2020.

In Montgomery County, the median sold price was \$525,000, down 2.8% from October 2021 and up 7.1% from November 2020. Closed sales were 1,235, representing a 3.7% decrease from the previous month and a 3.1% increase from November 2020.

Average days on the market were 21 in Montgomery County and 28 in the District.

Nationally, the typical home spent 47 days on the market in November, down 10 days from the same time last year and down 23 days from 2019, according to <u>Realtor.com's November housing market trends report</u>.

"As temperatures start to dip for the winter, the housing market continues to sizzle," said 2021 GCAAR President Jan Brito. "With an average of 24 days on the market, homes in our region are selling almost twice as fast as homes nationwide."

Regionally, there was a 12.3% month-over-month decrease in new contract activity with 2,034 New Pendings; a 7.5% month-over-month decrease in All Pendings (new contracts + contracts carried over from October) to 2,579; and a 19.8% decrease in supply to 2,745 active units.
