GCAAR renews partnership with Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland to support affordable homeownership opportunities, education

ROCKVILLE, Md. – The Greater Capital Area Association of REALTOR® (GCAAR), the local REALTOR® association serving Montgomery County, Md. and the District of Columbia, and Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland, Inc. (HFHMM), have renewed a strategic partnership focused on supporting affordable homeownership opportunities and homeowner education in the region through the end of 2027. The organizations' initial, three-year partnership began in 2022 and expired at the end of 2024.

Habitat for Humanity's mission of building strength, stability, self-reliance and affordable housing dovetails with GCAAR's focus of fostering homeownership opportunities for everyone, especially in traditionally underserved communities. Habitat works to increase access to homeownership through the rehab of vacant, distressed properties, new construction, home repair programs and advocacy for additional housing units.

Since the collaboration began between the two organizations three years ago, GCAAR has provided an annual financial contribution to support the education of housing recipients through the program. And more than 135 GCAAR volunteers have contributed almost 1,000 volunteer hours through Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland's Build Days and ReStore, Habitat's secondhand retail outlet. GCAAR members comprise REALTORS® and real-estate affiliated companies in Montgomery County and the District.

In addition to financing homeowner education and participating in Build Days and ReStore as part of the new, three-year partnership, GCAAR will also provide volunteers for HFHMM's Neighborhood Engagement initiative, which focuses on grounds beautification, mulching, planting farm-to-cafeteria foods, creating bio-retention ponds, building planters and more.

"Habitat for Humanity Metro Maryland is proud to serve more lower-income families than ever before, helping them experience the lasting benefits of affordable homeownership," said Jeffrey Dee, the organization's president & CEO. "GCAAR's generous support and sponsorship of our Homebuyer Education Program play a vital role in preparing our homeowners for long-term success—for years and generations to come."
